A public hearing was opened up at 6:00 pm to consider levying additional or increased millage rates without further voter approval or adopting the adjusted millage rates after reassessment and rolling forward to rates not to exceed the prior year's maximum. The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next year from the increased millage is \$30,875.60, and the amount of increase in taxes attributable to the millage increase is \$88.22.

The public hearing was adjourned at 6:10 pm.

The introduction of budgetary amendment for the Administration and the Police Department was introduced for next month's public hearing. The Council will be amending for the Police Department \$110,000.00; the Administration-80,000.00, Recreation-20,000.00 and Streets-10,000.00
